



Preference Education: Final Preferences and the Membership Recruitment Acceptance Binding Agreement (MRABA)

YOU ATTENDED TWO PREFERENCE EVENTS			
A	You would be willing to accept a bid from both chapters	Read and sign MRABA, ranking the two chapters.	You should receive a bid on Bid Day. You are not guaranteed your first choice. The MRABA is binding.
B	You would accept a bid from one chapter, and you would not accept a bid from the other chapter.	Read and sign MRABA. Limit your options by ranking only one chapter (<u>Intentional Single Preference</u>). <i>This does not increase your chances of matching with your first choice.</i>	If you do not receive a bid, Panhellenic will notify you that you are released from recruitment. <u>Options:</u> You are eligible for a snap bid.* You are eligible to receive a bid via Continuous Open Bidding (COB) after recruitment.
C	You would not accept a bid from either chapter.	Withdraw from recruitment.	<u>Options:</u> You are eligible for a snap bid.* You are eligible to receive a bid via COB after recruitment.
YOU ATTENDED ONE PREFERENCE EVENT			
D	You would accept a bid from that chapter	Read and sign the MRABA, ranking the chapter.	You should receive a bid on Bid Day. The MRABA is binding.
E	You would not accept a bid from that chapter.	Withdraw from recruitment.	<u>Options:</u> You are eligible for a snap bid.* You are eligible to receive a bid via COB after recruitment.

*If you receive a snap bid, you will attend Bid Day.

MRABA Implications

If you receive a bid from one of the sororities listed on your MRABA and then decide you do not want to join that chapter and decline your bid (now or later), you are ineligible to participate in COB. The next opportunity to join a sorority will be the next primary recruitment.

If you do not receive a bid from one of the sororities listed, you are eligible for a snap bid or COB.
