



Final Preferences and the Membership Recruitment Acceptance Binding Agreement (MRABA)

YOU ATTENDED TWO PREFERENCE EVENTS			
A	You are willing to accept a bid from either chapter	Read and sign the MRABA, ranking the two chapters.	You should receive a bid on Bid Day. Your first choice is not guaranteed. The MRABA is binding.
B	You are willing to accept a bid from <u>one</u> chapter. You are not willing to accept a bid from the other chapter.	Read and sign the MRABA. Limit your options by ranking only one chapter (<u>Intentional Single Preference</u>) <i>Limiting your options does not increase your chances of matching with your first choice.</i>	You could receive a bid on Bid Day. If you do not receive a bid, Panhellenic will notify you that you are released from recruitment. You are eligible to receive a bid via COB.
C	You are not willing to accept a bid from either chapter.	Withdraw from recruitment.	You are eligible to receive a bid via COB.
YOU ATTENDED ONE PREFERENCE EVENT			
D	You are willing to accept a bid from that chapter	Read and sign the MRABA, ranking the chapter.	You should receive a bid on Bid Day. The MRABA is binding.
E	You are not willing to accept a bid from that chapter.	Withdraw from recruitment.	You are eligible to receive a bid via COB.

Membership Recruitment Acceptance Binding Agreement (MRABA) Implications

If you receive a bid from one of the sororities listed on your MRABA and decide not to join that chapter and decline your bid (now or later), you are not eligible to receive a bid from another College Panhellenic chapter on the campus until the next primary recruitment.

If you do not receive a bid from one of the sororities listed, you are immediately eligible to receive a bid from any chapter.
