Membership Recruitment Acceptance Binding Agreement (MRABA) Implications

If you <u>receive a bid</u> from one of the sororities listed on your MRABA and decide not to join that chapter and decline your bid (now or later), you are not eligible to receive a bid from another College Panhellenic chapter on the campus until the next primary recruitment.

If you <u>do not receive a bid</u> from one of the sororities listed, you are immediately eligible to receive a bid from any chapter.
