



Membership Recruitment Acceptance Binding Agreement (MRABA) Education Logistics

Pre-Recruitment

- Educate potential new members (PNMs) and caregivers about the MRABA on the College Panhellenic's and/or fraternity/sorority life website, social media accounts, and during campus orientation sessions.
- Post the MRABA on the recruitment software message board or the recruitment registration landing/confirmation page.
- Email a PDF of a blank MRABA to all registered PNMs before the first day of recruitment, explaining this document must be signed to receive a bid at the end of the process.

Recruitment Counselor Training

- Train and educate recruitment counselors on the MRABA.
 - Review the MRABA, walk through the script and watch the [NPC MRABA script recording](#) with all recruitment counselors.
 - Use the [Preference Education: Final Preferences and the MRABA one-pager](#).
- Answer any questions. If unsure of answers, email mraba@npcwomen.org or your College Panhellenic area advisor.
- Empower recruitment counselors to refer PNMs to the fraternity/sorority life staff if they receive questions they are unsure how to answer.

PNM Orientation

- Review the MRABA in a large group meeting with all PNMs and recruitment counselors.
- Recruitment counselors should review the MRABA in small groups as well.
 - Please remind recruitment counselors they do not need to know the answer to every question asked by a PNM. They can say, "let me get back to you," then go ask an expert and respond to the PNM.

Preference Round

- *After preference round schedules are posted and before the preference round begins:*
 - Recruitment counselors should re-review the MRABA in small groups.
 - Email the [NPC MRABA script and script recording](#) to all PNMs still in the process.
- *After preference round:*
 - All PNMs must watch the [NPC MRABA script recording](#) in large or small groups before signing the MRABA.

Signing the MRABA

Find a centralized location for MRABA final education and signing.

- Campus staff or alumnae volunteers must review the MRABA with PNMs one last time in a way that meets the needs of your campus. Either:
 - One-on-one, OR
 - In large or small groups.
- PNMs should review and read a paper copy of the MRABA.
- PNMs should complete the MRABA electronically and/or via a paper version.
