

## 2022-23 Financial Activities

The 2022-23 National Panhellenic Conference (NPC) financial results show a significant change from the years most impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. In particular, this year, revenues rose as the per capita fee reached the \$5 mark initially envisioned in 2018 with the change to the Conference business model. This increased income was used to support Conference priorities through the addition of staff focused on growth and recruitment, advocacy and marketing campaigns at the local and national levels, and improvements to technology and data infrastructure.
