



## 2022-23 Annual Survey Highlights: Fast Facts

Data submitted by National Panhellenic Conference (NPC) member organizations as of June 15, 2023

### Membership

#### Size and scope

- 26 member organizations report 342,851 total undergraduates. This represents a 3.2 percent decrease from the prior academic year.
  - Although membership has decreased, a long-term review shows that undergraduate membership still remains higher than it was 10 years prior. In 2012-13, NPC organizations reported total membership at 325,772.
- 26 member organizations report 3,281 chartered and newly establishing collegiate chapters. This represents slightly more than a one percent decrease from the prior academic year when 3,309 chapters were reported.
- 26 member organizations report 3,310 alumnae chapters currently, which is 143 fewer than the previous year.
- 26 member organizations report a total of 5,828,206 women currently initiated into our organizations.

### Retention

- 26 member organizations report 125,426 women were pledged into membership during the 2022-23 academic year.
  - 26 member organizations report 119,402 women were initiated. This is roughly 95 percent of the women pledged.
  - The number of women initiated into our organizations in 2022-23 decreased by 5 percent from the prior year.
- 23 member organizations report 29,501 initiated members resigned from our organizations.

### Scholarships and Financial Assistance

- 26 member organizations report a total of \$6,668,350 in scholarships awarded to members.

### Philanthropy and Volunteering

- Total dollars raised for all philanthropy organizations by alumnae and collegians: \$28,061,185. (19 member organizations reported statistics.)
- Total hours volunteered overall for philanthropy (partners and non-partners) by alumnae and collegians: 5,203,779. (12 member organizations reported statistics.)
