

 Present recruitment rules to delegates and vote to approve the recruitment rules at the next College Panhellenic meeting. Be sure to use the Recruitment Rules Template.

- Close the recruitment counselor application. Hold recruitment counselor interviews and review the time commitments and important dates with all candidates.
 Make your final recruitment counselor selections.
- Create a recruitment marketing plan, including but not limited to social media, print media and in-person marketing.

Winter/Spring Recruitment Campuses (ten-twelve months before recruitment)

- Distribute surveys to gather feedback from registered potential new members (PNMs), advisors, College Panhellenic officers and recruitment counselors from the previous primary recruitment.
- Evaluate primary recruitment using the Recruitment Success Assessment. Determine any necessary shifts needed for the next primary recruitment.
