

NPC Foundation's Phi Mu Academic Excellence Fund Grant Program

Through a generous donation from Phi Mu Fraternity to create the NPC Foundation's Phi Mu Academic Excellence Fund, the NPC Foundation offers grants to College Panhellenics in support of creating a climate in which there is a constant presence and appreciation of academic excellence.

These grants from the NPC Foundation's Phi Mu Academic Excellence Fund can help College Panhellenics defray the cost of academic excellence programming. The NPC Foundation also hopes the program encourages College Panhellenics to be even more creative in how you support the academic pursuits of the Panhellenic women on your campus.

How to apply

The NPC Foundation expects to award up to \$3,000 per grant. Applications for grants from the NPC Foundation's Phi Mu Academic Excellence Fund will be accepted on a rolling basis throughout the year with the cutoff dates for review of **May 15** and **Oct. 15.** After the review committee meets, applicants will be notified in June and November, respectively.

To be eligible the College Panhellenic must have paid NPC dues by Oct. 1 and have completed the current year's Annual Reports in FS Central.

Application Process

- Plan for your College Panhellenic academic excellence programming.
 (Note: Keep all receipts and records as that will be needed to support your request.)
- Complete the <u>Academic Excellence Grant Application</u> in SmarterSelect to apply for a grant from the NPC Foundation's Phi Mu Academic Excellence Fund. You will be asked to provide:
 - Contact information.
 - Date(s) the program will be held.
 - Amount of funds being requested.
 - A description of the program and how funds will be used.
 - How the program promotes academic excellence in the Panhellenic community.
 - The number of Panhellenic women that will be impacted.

If your College Panhellenic is selected to receive a grant from the NPC Foundation's Phi Mu Academic Excellence Fund, you will be asked to provide additional details to support your request (e.g., speaker fee receipts, vendor invoices, restaurant detailed receipts). The NPC Foundation will then mail a check for the grant to your College Panhellenic.
