2025 College Panhellenic Academy Registration is Open!

Registration for the 2025 College Panhellenic Academy is open! This dynamic learning experience provides participants with the most up-to-date Panhellenic knowledge and reaffirms their commitment to NPC standards and values through interaction with energetic keynote speakers and facilitators. Participants will also be able to expand their networks by engaging with Panhellenic leaders from other campuses.

NPC will host College Panhellenic Academy in person at The Embassy Suites by Hilton Plainfield Indianapolis Airport on Jan. 24-25, 2025. With the 2025 Academy experience, we will offer small and large group education with specific educational tracks for presidents, marketing officers, peer accountability officers, two tracks for recruitment officers (recruitment counselors and operations), and a track for fraternity/sorority advisors. Information about tracks, hotel blocks, registration, and more can be found on the NPC website. The 2025 College Panhellenic Academy registration costs \$275 per person through Nov. 30, 2024. On Dec. 1, the fee will increase to \$299/person.

NPC Unanimous Agreements and Policies - 2024 Adopted Legislation

For all College Panhellenic officers and fraternity/sorority advisors

This fall, the NPC Council of Delegates added, removed and modified a number of Unanimous Agreements and policies. While a new edition of the NPC Manual of Information reflecting these changes will not be published online until January, we are sharing a handout that outlines the changes made. This handout provides the rationale for each change.

Recruitment Tasks This Month

For all College Panhellenic presidents, recruitment officers and advisors

Regardless of your primary recruitment term, there are always tasks to be completed.

Refer to the Recruitment Monthly Task List for a complete list of monthly recruitment tasks.

7all Recruitment Campuses

(10-12 months before recruitment)

- Distribute surveys to gather feedback from registered potential new members (PNMs), chapter officers, chapter advisors, College Panhellenic officers and recruitment counselors from the previous primary recruitment.
- Evaluate primary recruitment using the Recruitment Success
 Assessment. Determine any necessary shifts needed for the next primary recruitment.
 - If applicable, secure recruitment venues and facilities.
- Determine the recruitment counselor application timeline and make necessary edits to the application.

Winter/Spring Recruitment Campuses

(2 months before recruitment)

- Send all registered PNMs a welcome email from the vice president of recruitment if not completed earlier.
- Create an email campaign with a list of topics to inform and educate PNMs the two months before recruitment.
- Plan and conduct sorority info sessions for PNMs.
- Have recruitment counselors contact all registered PNMs directly via text message or direct message for engagement, education and support.
- Create monthly community-wide social media pushes (Add Yours, questions, story templates) for organic promotion of your sorority community.
 - Develop a plan to get your sorority community to share their experiences on a particular day.
 - Coordinate content with the social media chairs from

- chapters on campus on topics and timing to amplify content they are already creating.
- Create a theme or topic for the day to guide members on what they post.
