

NPC Annual Dues - Past Due Reminder

For all College Panhellenic officers

Dues invoices were posted in FS Central the first week of August and were due to the **NPC office on Oct. 1**. If your Panhellenic still needs to pay, we ask that you do so by the end of this month. College Panhellenics with nine or fewer chapters pay \$55 per chapter.

College Panhellenics with ten or more chapters pay \$65 per chapter. Dues must be paid to receive many NPC benefits, such as insurance, marketing or recruitment coaching, or attending College Panhellenic Academy. NOW OPEN! 2025 College Panhellenic Academy Registration

For all College Panhellenic officers and fraternity/sorority advisors

Registration for the 2025 College Panhellenic Academy is now open! This dynamic learning experience provides participants with the most up-to-date Panhellenic knowledge and reaffirms their commitment to NPC standards and values through interaction with energetic keynote speakers and facilitators. Participants will also have an opportunity to expand their networks by engaging with Panhellenic leaders from other campuses.

With the 2025 Academy experience, we will offer small and large group education with specific educational tracks for presidents, marketing officers, peer accountability officers, two tracks for recruitment officers (recruitment operations and recruitment counselors), and a track for fraternity/sorority advisors. Information about tracks, hotel blocks, registration, and more can be found on the NPC website. The 2025 College Panhellenic Academy **registration costs \$250 per person until Nov. 30, 2024.**

Recruitment Tasks This Month

For all College Panhellenic presidents, recruitment officers and advisors Regardless of your primary recruitment term, there are always tasks to be completed. Refer to the Recruitment Monthly Task List for a complete list of monthly recruitment tasks.

Fall Recruitment Campuses

Winter/Spring Recruitment Campuses

(1 month after recruitment)

(3 months before recruitment)

- Distribute surveys to gather feedback from registered potential new members (PNMs), chapter officers, chapter advisors, College Panhellenic officers and recruitment counselors from the previous primary recruitment.
- Evaluate primary recruitment using the Recruitment Success Assessment and/or Comprehensive Recruitment Assessment. Determine any necessary shifts needed for the next primary recruitment.

- The recruitment registration link should go LIVE 3 months before the start of recruitment.
- Send an email confirmation of registration to all PNMs. One week later, follow up with a welcome email from the vice president of recruitment or panhellenic president expressing encouragement and excitement.
- Assign recruitment counselors as soon as PNMs register so that they can engage PNMs via intentional outreach with detailed information about recruitment expectations and education.
- Create a recruitment registration checklist graphic to post frequently on Instagram stories.
 - List items needed for registration and the time to complete it.
 - List where PNMs can find links to register.
