Celebrate as a College Panhellenic:

- Send [certificates of appreciation](#) to all chapter advisors and staff.
- Feature National Advisor Appreciation Month on your College Panhellenic website.
- If your campus has chapter facilities with kitchens, sponsor a progressive dinner for your chapter advisors and College Panhellenic administrative staff.
- Sponsor a month-long chapter penny drive to raise funds to donate in honor of your advisors to your foundation, the NPC Foundation or a university foundation.
- At a chapter meeting, invite members to write thank-you notes and notes of appreciation to your advisors.
- Send a [letter to the editor](#) of your campus and local newspapers explaining why you appreciate all those who support your College Panhellenic community.
- Ask your college/university president to declare an Advisor Appreciation Day.
