### **About NPC's Governance Structure**

The NPC structure and governance model includes a seven-member Board of Directors consisting of five members elected to service by the Council of Delegates and two directors appointed by their member organization (on a rotational basis). The NPC chair is also elected by the Council of Delegates. The Board of Directors has authority and responsibility for overseeing the affairs of the Conference. They establish corporate policy, set the strategic direction, provide fiduciary oversight and monitor organizational performance.

The Council of Delegates consists of one representative from each of NPC's 26 member organizations and has primary responsibility for Conference membership, Unanimous Agreements and Panhellenic policies. The NPC workforce, both staff and volunteers, is led by the CEO and charged with accomplishing the work of the Conference.
