The 2024-25 National Panhellenic Conference (NPC) financial results continue to show steady growth following the years when the industry was most impacted by declining aggregate membership. In particular, this year, revenues rose slightly as we experienced a 3% uptick in undergraduate membership. Increased income was used to support Conference priorities through the establishment of more sophisticated marketing campaigns focused on the growth of our communities, as well as advocacy efforts specific to campus policies and federal legislation to champion the sorority experience.
