PAST DUE: NPC Annual Report

For College Panhellenic presidents and advisors

College Panhellenic annual reports for 2025-26 are now past due. Please complete those as soon as possible to remain in good standing with NPC.

These reports can be found in FS Central under your College Panhellenic's profile, then under "Reporting," and then under "Submit Other Reports."

There are five reports (marketing, operations, philanthropy and service, programming and recruitment). They can be saved intermittently before completion if necessary. Annual report responses allow NPC to provide adequate resources to your College Panhellenic and understand larger trending concerns.

NPC needs to know this information in order to properly support your recruitment, and assign your College Panhellenic an RFM specialist.

Resource Spotlight

Bid Matching and Bid Distribution Timelines The NPC Council of Delegates voted on changes to Unanimous Agreement VI that affect the timing of bid distribution and

the announcement of total for the 2026-27 academic year.

We recommend that College Panhellenic recruitment officers and fraternity/sorority advisors check out the [Resolved to Educate on Bid Matching to Bid Distribution](#) as well as the [Bid Matching to Bid Distribution Flowchart](#). Every College Panhellenic hosting a structured recruitment process should plan for a snap bidding window, regardless of whether or not you think you may need it.

As you can see in the resources linked, total is set and announced after the snap bidding period, so that COB and snap bidding do not overlap. For College Panhellenics that use RFM, total is announced when the RFM specialist shares the Community Health Report with your fraternity/sorority advisor(s) and member organizations.

We recommend the fraternity/sorority advisors\ shares total as soon as possible with the chapters on their campus as it will also likely be shared from the inter/national organization to the local chapter. For College Panhellenics that do not have RFM, the total specialist will announce total via email in a similar fashion, with a copy to the member organizations, and the fraternity/sorority advisor.

In case you missed it, all of these changes were outlined in April's College Panhellenic newsletter, where NPC shared the following [handout outlining policy changes that will take effect next academic year \(2026-27\)](#). This handout explains and provides a rationale for each change.
