



NPC Dues Overview for College Panhellenics

Who pays NPC dues?

- College Panhellenic Associations
- Alumnae Panhellenic Associations
- All 26 NPC Member Organizations

How much are NPC dues?

- College Panhellenic Associations with 2-9 chapters: \$75 USD per chapter
- College Panhellenic Associations with 10+ chapters: \$85 USD per chapter
- NPC only bills College Panhellenics for regular members of the College Panhellenic (associate members are not counted).

When is NPC's dues billing cycle?

- NPC invoices dues on or around August 1 of each year.
- NPC dues payments are due October 1 of each year.

How do I pay NPC dues?

- Invoices can be found under the Billing icon of your College Panhellenic's page on FS Central.
- If paying by card please use the Billing icon of your College Panhellenic's page on FS Central.
- If paying by check please mail a copy of the invoice and the check to:

- NOTE: If individual chapters are sending checks, please add a note in the envelope or to the memo line of the check that designates what College Panhellenic the chapter is a member of.

What are NPC dues used for?

Your NPC dues pay for support resources that are provided to all College Panhellenic associations. In your role as a College Panhellenic officer, the most common support personnel you'd need/use are:

- Dedicated NPC College Panhellenic area advisor
- Dedicated NPC College Panhellenic area advisor coordinator (This person manages all of the area advisors in a cluster and is the next step in support after your assigned area advisor.)
- Trained specialists including:
 - Release figure methodology (RFM) specialist or total specialist
 - Growth Coach/Panhellenic Recruitment Committee member



- Marketing Coach
- NPC staff
- Database tools like FS Central

You may also use the following resources:

- NPC Manual of Information (MOI) - updated every six months
- Peer Accountability process guide
- Extension materials
- Model bylaws and recruitment rules
- Primary recruitment style guides
