Following the survey sent to Alumnae Panhellenics in the summer of 2025, the NPC Board of Directors have authorized an updated version of the Alumnae Panhellenics purpose statement that reads:

An Alumnae Panhellenic Association is a community-based organization chartered by the National Panhellenic Conference. Alumnae Panhellenic Associations exist to promote the sorority experience through local engagement of NPC member

organization alumnae members and support for collegiate scholarships for current and potential members.

Key Dates

- **Jan. 19 - Feb. 22-** 2026-28 NPC Standing Committee Interest Form and Volunteer Application open. Anyone wishing to serve on the five NPC Standing Committees open for the 2026-28 biennium must complete the interest form or application as directed above. Please distribute this information widely.
- **March-** NPC Board of Directors appoints NPC Standing Committee leadership and NPC Chief Executive Officer appoints NPC Standing Committee members. All applicants are notified of appointments.
- **June 5-7-** College Panhellenic Area Advisor Training in Indianapolis, Indiana.
- **July 1-** Volunteer service begins.

Additional Information to Note

To eliminate both confusion and burnout, the below best practices have been created and will be followed during the appointment process:

- The maximum number of committees an individual can serve on is two (for current committee members); new volunteers will only be able to serve on one committee.
- A member organization chief panhellenic officer or delegate will not be appointed as an NPC standing committee chair.
- A member organization staff member who works in chapter services/member services/risk reduction will not be assigned to serve/work directly with a campus where they have a chapter.
- Per the NPC bylaws, a committee chair can serve for only two consecutive terms.
- Per NPC board policy, an individual may serve on the leadership team of only one standing committee at any given time.
- Per NPC board policy, an individual may not serve on a standing committee leadership team if they are concurrently serving on their organization's inter/national governing board.
- All volunteer interest forms and applications of members of the 26 member organizations will be sent to the organization's chief panhellenic officer for confirmation of the applicant's good standing and the member organization's willingness to sponsor that applicant financially (if they are applying for the College Panhellenic Committee as that has an in-person training).

Please share this information far and wide with as many current and potential volunteers as possible.
